Along with the likes of Elvis Costello, Nick Lowe, and the Damned, England's **Wreckless Eric** was part of the notorious Stiff Records, a British punk and new wave label that thrived in the late 70s and early 80s. 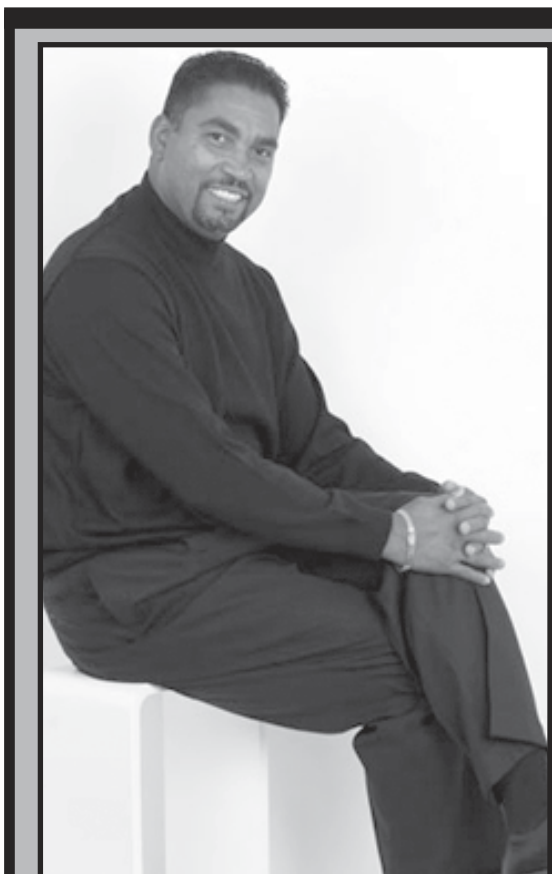
